Sujin Beck, Projects Assistant, presented the item to the Authorities. The staff update of the Camarillo Beacon project provided the location, cost and timeline of the project. Questions from the Authorities were heard and addressed by staff. Public comment heard.

Action: Without motion, the Authorities receives and files a staff update on the Camarillo Airport Beacon Tower Installation Project.

C. <u>Subject</u>: Receive and File a Staff Presentation Regarding Solicitation for Letters of Interest – Development Parcels at Camarillo Airport

Recommendation:

Receive and file a staff presentation regarding solicitation for Letters of Interest – two parcels at Camarillo Airport.

Keith Freitas, Director of Airports, presented the item to the Authorities. The presentation provided an update regarding two separate requests to develop at Camarillo Airport now that the Airport Layout Plan Update has been completed. The Department of Airports will next solicit for other competitive interest as required by the FAA. Questions and comments from the Authorities were heard and addressed by staff. Public comment was heard.

D. <u>Subject</u>: Approval of, and Authorization for the Director of Airports or His Designee to Sign, Consulting Services Contract with Ninyo & Moore Geotechnical & Environmental Sciences Consultants for the Supplemental Per and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Soil and Groundwater Investigation at Oxnard Airport for \$129,660.48

Recommendation:

Staff requests that your Commission/Authorities recommend that the Board of Supervisors (Board):

Authorize the Director of Airports or his designee to sign the consulting services contract with Ninyo & Moore Geotechnical & Environmental Sciences Consultants for the supplemental per and polyfluoroalkyl substances soil and groundwater investigation at Oxnard Airport for \$129.660.48.

Erin Powers, Deputy Director, presented the item to the Authorities for its recommended approval and authorization to sign a consulting services contract with Ninyo & Moore. The presentation gave an overview of the services Ninyo & Moore would provide at Oxnard Airport related to Per and Polyfluoroalkyl Substances Soil (PFAS).

Action: Upon the motion of Supervisor Vianey Lopez and seconded by Vice Chair Barbara Filkins, the Authority hereby approves the recommendations as stated in the respective agenda letter for item 7.D. All members voted and the motion passed unanimously 4-0.

8. DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Director Freitas opened the Director's Report by introducing Lizet Kennel as the new Management Assistant for the Department of Airports.

Heart Aerospace, a Swedish based company, relocated its headquarters to Irvine, California. Heart Aerospace focuses on midsize electric engines, that can accommodate 70 passengers. Their team was looking for a research and development test range. We were able to offer a 6-month lease at Oxnard Airport. We're excited share that we will have a video to present at the next meeting. This pushes our Advanced Air Mobility that we are encouraging at Oxnard Airport.

On August 7th, the Canyon Fire broke out near the Ventura-Los Angeles County line. Camarillo Airport served as a staging area to help support firefighting efforts. The Ventura County Fire and Sheriff's Air Units assisted in responding quickly and effectively. The Canyon Fire was 91% contained within just a couple of days and fully contained by August 14th. Another outstanding job by our Ventura County Air Units.

The Wings Over Camarillo held its 44th annual event on August 17th and 18th. The Department would like to thank (Air Boss)Bill Thomas, and all the volunteers for organizing such a well-run and successful event. Bill is still finalizing the numbers, but the preliminary count shows approximately 17,000 attendees. He will provide a full debriefing at one of the upcoming meetings.

Director Freitas shared the image of him participating in the Pivitol flight simulator The 3-D goggles offer a real-life experience. During the Saturday event, Pivitol demonstrated a single person electric aircraft.

As briefly mentioned in the agenda review, the Point Mugu Public Information Officer informed us today that there will be increased air activity from September 5th through 19th, with the possibility of it extending beyond that period. Our Public Information Officer (Jannette Jauregui) will share this announcement with the Airports contact list.

Ventura County Animal Servies located at Camarillo Airport hosted its annual Clear the Shelters event on August 23rd. Animal Services reported they had a great turnout, and 68 animals found homes that day. That's approximately a week's worth of adoptions in a single day. It was a very successful event.

Erin Powers and her team working with Congresswoman Brownley's office secured a \$3-million grant for Oxnard Airport. The grant was backpay for the final work on Taxiway F and final paving project at Oxnard Airport. The cost was upfronted with no guarantee of reimbursement, but it was received and appreciated.

The Commemorative Air Force (CAF) is hosting the B-17 Sentimental Journey from September 22nd to September 29th. Public tours and rides will be available to the public and can be arranged on their website.

Several years ago, the Sheriff's Academy utilized a portion of the abandoned runway at Camarillo Airport for high-speed vehicle training, and are requesting to do so again. Airport staff is reassessing that request and working with our engineering consultants to determine whether such use would be permissible. The training is typically held twice a year for its academy recruits.

Lastly, Director Freitas Reminds the Authorities that the terms for our two public members, Barbara Filkins and Scott Barer, expire on February 28, 2026. The Department will announce the application process for the new Camarillo/Oxnard Airport Authority public member in November. The next public member term will commence in March 2026.
